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

CALL TO ACTION

Early Education sponsorship changes the lives of preschool children and their families by ensuring the sustainability and growth of the high quality education provided in Colorado Springs. Most of the communities we serve are in low-income areas. Many children can only attend if we remove the barriers of paid tuition. Therefore, we rely heavily on financial gifts to ensure that no child is turned away due to lack of financial resources. Early Education sponsorship is utilized for tuition assistance, general operations of 5 non-profit preschools, future growth and to cover expenses such as preschool activity supplies, student snacks, facility utilities, facility maintenance and preschool teacher development.
